

Karpowership signed a 2-year contract with National Water and Electricity Supply Company Ltd. to deploy a Powership of 36 MW. In the following years, the contract was extended, as the Gambia's energy demand continued.

Karpowership has been operational in Gambia since 2018 and today supplies 40% of the country's total electricity need. In 2017, a year before Karpowership began its operations, only 56% of the population had access to electricity. Today, that figure has increased to 65%.

The 9% growth in access to electricity, along with the stability of the grid, allowed businesses to thrive and expand into new sectors. Most private institutions now draw their power from the grid, having previously relied on generators.

Before the deployment of the Powership, the country struggled with unreliable electricity, experiencing daily load-shedding. The public relied on daily newspapers for updates on electricity availability and shortages. However, once Karpowership began its operations, periodic load-shedding ceased, ensuring consistent access to electricity and significantly impacting the daily lives of communities and businesses in The Gambia.


