

## **One World Karadeniz Foundation Marks Seventh Global Children's Home Project with Renovation of Osu Children's Home in Ghana**

**Istanbul, Türkiye [13 December 2025]** The One World Karadeniz Foundation, the global CSR arm of Karpowership, today announced the completion and handover of a fully renovated boys' dormitory at the Osu Children's Home in Accra, marking the Foundation's seventh children's home project worldwide and reinforcing its growing international footprint in community-centered social development.

The comprehensive renovation includes upgraded tiling, carpentry and masonry works, plumbing repairs, fresh painting, and the installation of new beds, mattresses, ceiling fans, doors, and windows. Karpowership Ghana also donated food supplies and confectionaries as part of the handover.

Hon. Rita Naa Odoley Sowah, Member of Parliament for La Dade-Kotopon and Ghana's Deputy Minister for Local Government, Chieftaincy and Religious Affairs, described the initiative as a benchmark for corporate partnership in child welfare. "This renovation is a remarkable show of corporate responsibility and compassion. Providing these children with a conducive place to sleep will help them rejuvenate and strengthen their overall well-being. I encourage more companies to emulate this initiative, as supporting vulnerable children is a collective duty," she stated.

Representing Ghana's Minister for Gender, Children and Social Protection, Madam Agnes Abolimpoh, Deputy Director for Children's Welfare, added: "This project directly enhances the well-being and dignity of the boys in this Home. We are grateful for this timely and meaningful intervention."

### **Children Home Projects Globally**

The Osu Children's Home renovation is the latest series of children's home and child-welfare initiatives delivered by the One World Karadeniz Foundation across Africa and Latin America. To date, more than 300 children have directly benefited from these projects, which are designed and executed in close coordination with local communities and authorities.

#### **Sierra Leone – Variety of Children & Family Services**

The Foundation executed a full renovation of sleeping facilities, supplied 50 new beds and mattresses, and rehabilitated dormitories and common areas. The project restored safe and dignified living conditions for vulnerable children relying on the centre's services.

#### **The Gambia – Orphanage Learning Centre**

After a fire destroyed the facility, leaving children without shelter, the Foundation financed and

managed a full reconstruction of the children's home. The project reinstated safe learning and living spaces, ensuring continuity of care and education for displaced children.

#### **Senegal – SOS Children's Village**

The Foundation renovated key children's home facilities and constructed a football field that now provides a sustainable income stream for the Village. With the field rented out for community activities, the project combines immediate infrastructure upgrades with long-term economic empowerment.

#### **Gabon – Les Petits Anges de Dieu**

Work included the renovation of shelter facilities, sanitation improvements, bedding upgrades, enhancements to recreational areas, and support for educational materials and basic health needs. The project strengthened daily safety, dignity, and well-being.

#### **Ivory Coast – OFAA Orphanage**

The Foundation rehabilitated core infrastructure, provided essential equipment, and delivered structural and functional upgrades that significantly improved living standards and personal development opportunities for children under state care.

#### **Guinea Conakry – Regina Maris Center**

The project focused on the renovation of key children's home facilities, contributing to the centre's ability to provide a stable and nurturing environment for children in its care.

#### **Ecuador – Ines Chambers Orphanage**

In-kind donations were provided to support education, nutrition, and other essential needs, expanding the Foundation's children's welfare impact footprint to Latin America.

#### **Broader Social Impact Portfolio**

The children's home initiative operates alongside the Foundation's broader focus on education, women's empowerment, and environmental stewardship. More than \$2.5 million has been invested to support education for over 55,000 students worldwide.

Flagship programmes include *Girl Power*, launched in 2014 to help girls remain in school and build pathways into leadership, and the Foundation's partnership with Mozambique's *Girl Move Academy*, which strengthens women's education through mentoring and leadership development.

The Foundation also delivers a wide range of community-driven initiatives across its global footprint, guided by the "One World" ethos of advancing social progress wherever Karpowership operates. These initiatives focus on women's empowerment, education and youth development, community wellbeing, and environmental stewardship, including reforestation and sustainability-focused projects.
